The Small Animal Clinic at the Freie Universität Berlin is seeking a lecturer in small animal internal medicine for clinical service, including teaching and clinical research. The responsibilities of this position involve the clinical instruction of residents, interns, and veterinary students in the Teaching Hospital. There is ample opportunity to participate in rounds, seminars, and for professional development. Available state-of-the art equipment includes a modern in-house laboratory, a blood bank, computerized medical record system, an intensive care unit, video endoscopy, radiography and fluoroscopy, a helical computer tomography, abdominal ultrasound, color flow Doppler echocardiography, and a linear accelerator. The candidate should have a veterinary degree, a doctoral degree or equivalent and be a diplomate in the European (ECVIM) or American (ACVIM) College of Veterinary Internal Medicine. German and English speaking candidates are equally encouraged to apply. Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
